

## Polling - Refugees

### **April 2017**

#### **Key Results**

The Australia Institute surveyed 1,408 Australians about asylum seekers and refugees.

Respondents were asked how they would like to see asylum seekers and refugees who arrive in Australia by boat to be managed:

- Almost three quarters (72%) of respondents think those assessed to be genuine refugees who arrive in Australia by boat should be allowed to stay in Australia; of these 37% said they should be brought directly to Australia to have their claims assessed, 35% say their claims should be assessed in offshore detention first.
- One quarter (24%) of respondents said that asylum seekers should be sent to camps on Manus Island and Nauru and none should be allowed to come to Australia under any circumstances.

Survey respondents were asked whether they agreed or disagreed with a series of statements about the 'refugee swap' deal between the USA and Australia.

- Half of respondents (51%) disagree that Donald Trump will follow through on the agreement (agree 28%, don't know 21%)
- More people disagreed (46%) with the statement 'the agreement is a good way to manage the asylum seeker issue' than agreed (agree 40%, don't know 14%)
- Half of respondents (56%) agree that people in the camps who are found to be genuine refugees should be brought immediately to Australia, not wait longer to see when or if the USA will take them (disagree 34%, don't know 10%)

#### Method

Between 26 April May and 5 May 2017 The Australia Institute conducted a national opinion poll of 1,408 people through Research Now, with nationally representative samples by gender, age and state or territory.

Those who were undecided were asked which way they were leaning. These leanings are included in voting intention crosstabs. "LNP" includes separate responses for Liberal and National. "Other" includes Nick Xenophon Team, Australian Conservatives and Independent/Other.
