


Figure: Support for a Commonwealth Integrity Commission over time (Australia Institute polling)

September 2017: "A National Independent Commission Against Corruption would investigate and expose corruption in federal politics. Do you support or oppose establishing a National Independent Commission Against Corruption?"

From March 2019: "A Commonwealth Integrity Commission would investigate corruption within federal law enforcement, the public service, service providers, contractors, federal parliamentarians and their staff. Do you support or oppose setting up a Commonwealth Integrity Commission?"
